SUBJECT **Prado 250 Series – AdBlue**

The 250 Series Prado uses AdBlue to reduce diesel emissions. Follow these simple steps for smooth operation.



Please note the following important points:

- AdBlue is not a Fuel Additive, and it is **only to be placed in the AdBlue filler** as shown in the photo below
- If you accidentally put AdBlue in the fuel tank **DO NOT START THE VEHICLE**
- This is not covered by insurance
- The vehicle will need to need to be towed to the nearest Toyota dealership for rectification at the cost of the renter



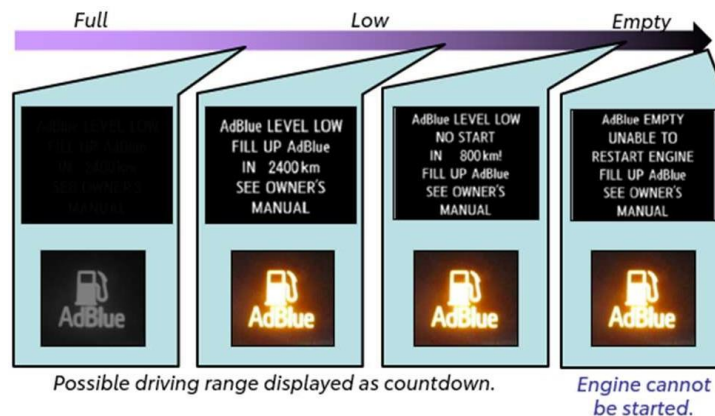
Like fuel, if you run out of AdBlue you cannot restart the vehicle.

You will receive multiple warnings at various intervals prior to AdBlue running out.

If the warning occurs, please top it up at your earliest convenience.

If you run out, you will need to fill AdBlue with a minimum of 10.5 litres.

Note: Roadside Assist callouts and associated costs including towing are the responsibility of the renter.



If travelling to remote locations you must top up prior or carry enough AdBlue to maintain normal operation of the vehicle.

AdBlue is corrosive and if you spill it on your vehicle or on yourself you must wash it off immediately.
